Elderly/handicapped public housing: To be eligible for state-aided elderly/handicapped public housing, an applicant must be low income and be age 60 or over, or if less than 60 years of age, must have a qualifying disability. To apply online, you must use the Common Housing Application for Massachusetts Public Housing (CHAMP) website. If you do not want to apply online, you can complete the CHAMP paper application.
