She defined nursing as "an interpersonal process whereby the professional nurse practitioner assists an individual, family or community to prevent or cope with experience or illness and suffering, and if necessary, to find meaning in these experiences".

The theory was presented in her book, *Interpersonal Aspects of Nursing*, which was published in 1961. The assumptions of the model are based on Soren Kierkegaard's philosophy of existentialism and Viktor Frankl's logotherapy. Existentialism places the accountability for people's choices in life on the people who make those choices.
