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## **Intervention Strategies For Infants And**

Early childhood intervention strategies depends on the type of developmental delay the child has as well as how the child is diagnosed. Normally, interventions may include speech therapy, occupational therapy, psychological counseling, vision therapy, and physical therapy. Speech Therapy: This type of therapy would be used for language and communication delays.

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## Part C of the Individuals With Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), is a federal grant program that assists states in operating a comprehensive statewide program of services and supports for children birth through 2 years old with developmental delays, including (at state option) children who are "at risk" of developing a delay or special need that may affect their development or impede their education.

Examples of intervention in child maltreatment include the investigation of child abuse reports by state child protection agencies, clinical treatment of physical and psychological injuries, family counseling, self-help services, the provision of goods and services such as homemaker or respite care, legal action against the perpetrator, and removal of the child or the offender from the home.

### **Understanding Child Abuse ...**

Parent-Child Interaction Therapy (PCIT) is an evidence-based parent-training intervention that may be well suited for infants. With theoretical foundations in attachment and social learning, PCIT was designed to strengthen the parent-child interaction to change child behavior (Brinkmeyer & Eyberg, 2003).
