Here we find five muscles known as the biceps brachii, brachialis, coracobrachialis, triceps brachii and anconeus. The former three occupy the anterior compartment of the arm, and are involved in forearm flexion.

Conversely the triceps brachii, located in the posterior compartment of the arm, is primarily involved in forearm extension.
