Don't eat or drink anything for six hours before your test. Hydration before a myelogram is very important; you should start drinking four to eight ounces of clear fluids every two hours the day before, and leading up to your test. Clear fluids are the only thing you're permitted to consume in the six hours directly before your test.

A myelogram is an invasive diagnostic test that uses x-rays to examine the spinal canal. A special dye is injected into the spinal canal through a hollow needle. An x-ray fluoroscope then records the images formed by the dye. Myelograms can show conditions affecting the spinal cord and nerves within the spinal canal.
