## **Parallelism Worksheet**

A sentence exhibits parallelism if similar ideas are expressed using the same syntactic and grammatical structure. Writers use parallel structures to communicate ideas that have the same importance using the same grammatical structure. Parallelism is most common using gerund phrases (verb + ing) or infinitives (to + verb).

## **Parallelism - Grammar Worksheets**

Parallelism is when closely related parts of a sentence fit together using similar grammatical form. It makes writing clearer and easier for the reader to understand. A.
