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Skoda 130 Rs Engine

The Škoda 130, Škoda 135 and Škoda 136 are three variations of a rear-engined, rear-wheel drive small family car that was produced by Czechoslovakian car manufacturer AZNP in Mladá Boleslav, Czechoslovakia between 1984 and 1990. The Škoda 130 is known internally as Type 742, and the Škoda 135/136 as Type 746.

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The most powerful engine to appear under the rear deck of ŠKODA 130 RS A5 was the Š 737 prototype unit, designed in cooperation with the Motor Vehicle Research Institute in Prague. The all-aluminium four-cylinder had a bore of 85 mm and stroke of 70 mm, resulting in 1,589 cc of displacement.

However, those engines quickly became obsolete—hence the 1975 introduction of the 130 RS. Featuring aluminum and fiberglass panels, and a 1.3 OHV engine tuned to 140 horsepower, the 1587-pound wonder dominated the Czechoslovakian rally scene before snagging a 1-2 finish in its class at the 1977 Monte Carlo Rally and another class victory at Rally Sweden.

The Czech's company's original idea for the 130 RS' replacement was to wait until the release of the front engine / front wheel drive Favorit platform but major delays in its development made it impossible. The rear-engine Škoda models were also on the verge of a revamp which further delayed the project.

The Škoda 130 RS was powered by a 1.3-litre four-cylinder petrol with OHV valve control. The 140-horsepower engine could take the car to 220 km/h. The engine's sports capabilities were made possible by the two Weber twin carburetors, an eight-channel cylinder head and dry sump lubrication.

The 130 LR Evolution (sometimes also referred to as the "130 LR/B") featured a wider bodywork package to allow an increase of its track widths. This allowed the fitment of 210/560 R13 tyres in

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the front and quite meaty 265/460 R13s in the rear, therefore much improving traction and stability especially on tarmac.

The 1.3-liter engine received a new, eight-port aluminium head to go with the previously used aluminium block. With twin Weber DCOE carburettors and a host of other upgrades, it produced 130 hp, transferred to the rear axle through the five-speed gearbox, mated with a limited-slip differential.
