The Therapeutic Crisis Intervention (TCI) training program for child and youth care staff presents a crisis prevention and intervention model designed to teach staff how to help children learn constructive ways to handle crisis.

Therapeutic Crisis Intervention (TCI) System Overview

It is a mandatory requirement that all care staff working within Children's Residential Services will receive a minimum of 28 hours training in Therapeutic Crisis Intervention. It is the responsibility of the Homes Registered Manager to nominate each new member of staff for the full T.C.I Training during their probation period.

3.7 Therapeutic Crisis Intervention - Good Practice Guidance

Therapeutic crisis intervention (TCI) is a mode of counseling that is practiced in extremely volatile and dangerous patient environments and that seeks to alter a patient's maladaptive coping mechanisms and destructive responses while encouraging constructive stress management habits. Rather than relying on force and restraint when dealing with aggressive patients, therapeutic crisis intervention emphasizes sensitivity, rules, leadership, and redirection.

What Is Therapeutic Crisis Intervention?

Crisis Intervention When someone has suffered a trauma, a therapist or qualified professional can support a healthier processing of an extreme situation. Helping someone after a crisis occurs helps them to gain a clear perspective and support when it is most needed.

Describe the Stress Model of Crisis opportunities between Triggering (agitation) and Escalation (Aggression). Your ENCOUNTER with the young person can either ENGAGE OR ENRAGE - If you engage, the youth can return to pre-crisis (baseline) phase; if you ENRAGE, the youth continues to Escalation (Aggression) phase.

This evidence-informed model is used to teach staff and carers how to help children handle stress in constructive ways. Therapeutic Crisis Intervention (TCI) and Therapeutic Crisis Intervention for Families (TCI-F) are crisis intervention models developed alongside CARE at Cornell University. Through this approach, children can learn constructive and adaptive ways to deal with frustration, failure, anger, rejection, hurt and depression when they see their carers manage crisis constructively.
